A message from Mr Cutts

We have packed lots into the first half term and the staff team have worked incredibly hard to give the children a successful start to the year. We are full speed ahead with our priorities for the year, including:

• Further enhancing our curriculum so that all children can excel in all subjects.

• Ensuring that all children access a broad and progressive wider curriculum, including social, spiritual, moral and cultural learning – building back our pre-COVID offer to an even higher standard.

• Further enhancing our Safeguarding and Wellbeing culture to secure an outstanding basis for learning to thrive.

We have already completed a large number of actions towards these goals and are very excited about the future as we (hopefully) emerge from the heavy impact of COVID.

On that subject, please do continue to remain vigilant around COVID symptoms and use twice weekly lateral flow tests at half term to help us limit any potential impact on school.

I have calculated that since last November, around 20% of Weston staff and pupils have had COVID to varying degrees, including almost 50% of the staff. Every case impacts on health and education and we continue to act with caution. Whilst nationally there is no planned change to COVID measures, local authority public health teams, informed by rapidly rising cases and growing pressure on the NHS, are demanding some form of national response. We watch with interest and are prepared to reinstate any mitigations necessary that would ultimately help us avoid any form of the partial closures or mass bubble isolations that we endured last year. That is the last thing we want. Our children need to be in school.

We look forward to seeing the children on **Tuesday 2 November**. Have a lovely half term!

Parent/Carer Consultation Evenings

We hope you were able to secure a good understanding of how your child has settled into their new class via our remote parent/carer consultation evenings. Please continue to communicate with your child's teacher via Class Dojo and don't hesitate to reach out if you require support or have any concerns. We are working on plans to showcase the children's work so that you are able to look through their books etc and get a further insight into how they are doing.
